Peer Support Specialists share lived experiences and knowledge to guide CRSP participants through the reentry process. Peer Support Specialists assist with removing barriers to successful reentry through emotional support and practical assistance in a community-based setting.

HOW CAN THE PROGRAM HELP?

CRSP takes a whole-person approach by connecting program participants with services and resources. Improving their overall wellness and reducing risk of reoffending.
